A Brief History of the PCCO

As remembered by Michael Dorn

Twenty years ago after a series of kitchen table discussions, in 1989, the solitary pagans of Central Ohio banded together with a decision to act as a community. Out of those discussions came the Pagan Community Council of Central Ohio (PCCCO) or as some came to call it – P3CO. Founded to provide community services (ecumenical, social and educational) for Central Ohio witches, druids, pagans and followers of other alternative religions, P3CO has been through several fits and starts in reaching out to those who can best be served by the organization.

Formed as a 501(c)(3) educational group, PCCCO filed for and was granted recognition by the IRS in 1991. Initially conceived as an umbrella organization that would support smaller groups who wished to reach out to the Pagan Community; this did not happen, PCCCO instead began offering events and a newsletter (YAPN – Yet Another Pagan Newsletter) to members and non-members. These events became very popular and P3CO changed the name to PCCO – Pagan Community Council of Ohio.

Some of the earliest events organized by PCCO were the Kenny and Tzipora concerts, of which there were two. Kenny and Tzipora Klein were a staple within the pagan community in the late '80's and early '90's. Traveling from venue to venue, Kenny and Tzipora were like the troubadours of old. Their songs and their path (Blue Star) were the message shared with the pagan community. True to their minstrel duties, Kenny & Tzipora helped open communication between local pagan groups that previously had no knowledge of each others existence. (This is where I came in.)

Soon PCCO started holding festivals and other events, the first festival held by PCCO was Shadowmas during Samhain 1991, Summerset and The Greening came along in 1992 and 1993, respectively. Summerset over Labor Day weekend and, initially, The Greening was held close to Beltaine over the first weekend of May. Soon The Greening was moved to Memorial Day weekend to avoid the need to dress warmly and the removal of ice off of tents most mornings. Camp O'Bannon Outpost was the site that PCCO rented for events at that time; this site had only two permanent buildings – a shelter house and a washroom. Tenting was not an option, but a necessity!

As time passed, PCCO added smaller events; marking the Wheel of the Year - Springbourne at Ostara, Brigid's Fire at Imbolc, Winterfire at Yule and once, Drumspirit in mid-July. Drumspirit was conceived to be a pagan music festival, but failed to meet expectations.

Locations for all these events have changed over the years as well. Summerset has moved from a skiing resort to Al Trusty's Christmas tree farm ("...that's no ordinary fire!"), to Camp O'Bannon Outpost (a favorite location) to Camp Wyandot (where the hills were a challenge). Lately, Summerset has been held at Camp Crooked Lane, Camp Graham and most recently, Camp Clifton. Winter events have been held at Camp O'Bannon Main Camp, Camp Wakatomica and Camp Mary Orton. Other events have been held at Camp Libbey near Defiance, Lake Camp near Oberlin and other locations.

Each event brings many memories, from events affected by weather such as "The Drowning" (The Greening 1995) to personal losses and remembrances, i.e., Leslie Dauterman's Memorial Service (Summerset 2000) over the years. Sometimes the campground provided memorable occurrences, other times festival attendees were most memorable.

Featured guests at these events over the years have included Ted Andrews, Issac Bonewits, Raven Grimassi, Patricia Mongahan (several times), Kerr Chullian, M. Macha Nightmare (twice), Jerri Hildebrand, Chris Forrester (from the UK) and Selena Fox. I apologize to anyone I may have forgotten. Most events also featured several local presenters to lead the workshops, they are too numerous to list here.

Pulling these events together were Stacy Brian Bartley and Leslie Dauterman. Mary Williams, Elric Windstar (later, Morningstar) and a cast of others, including myself, played the supporting roles necessary for the execution of these events.

PCCO has lost good people over the years. Individuals have moved away, found other interests or had personality conflicts with others are among many other excuses. The ones I miss the most are those who have crossed over to the Summerlands - Leslie Dauterman and Elric Morningstar had served as PCCO officers and effected change in the organization. Rick (Lord Spam) Allen's sudden passing had a stifling effect on event planning. More recently, members whose presence is missed include Terri Yutzy, Julie Moore and Charles Swan.
